***Exemption permit will not be extended beyond 30 days and can be suspended at anytime by the Utilities Superintendent based on water use and conditions.***

### **Lawn and Garden Watering Regulations**

The City of Monticello established a Water Conservation Ordinance under Lawn & Garden Regulations, which specifies an odd/even watering schedule from June 1 through September 30 every year.

Property addresses ending in an even number are allowed to water on even calendar days, and property addresses ending in an odd number are allowed to water on odd calendar days.

### **VIOLATIONS:**

First Offense:	Written warning
Second Offense:	\$25.00 surcharge
Third + Offense:	\$50.00 surcharge

### **Exemption Permits**

When residents put in new lawns or plant new trees, they can get a 30 day permit from the city's Utilities department. This permit allows residents to water every day during the 30 day period. The permit is a one time only exemption and cannot be renewed.
